

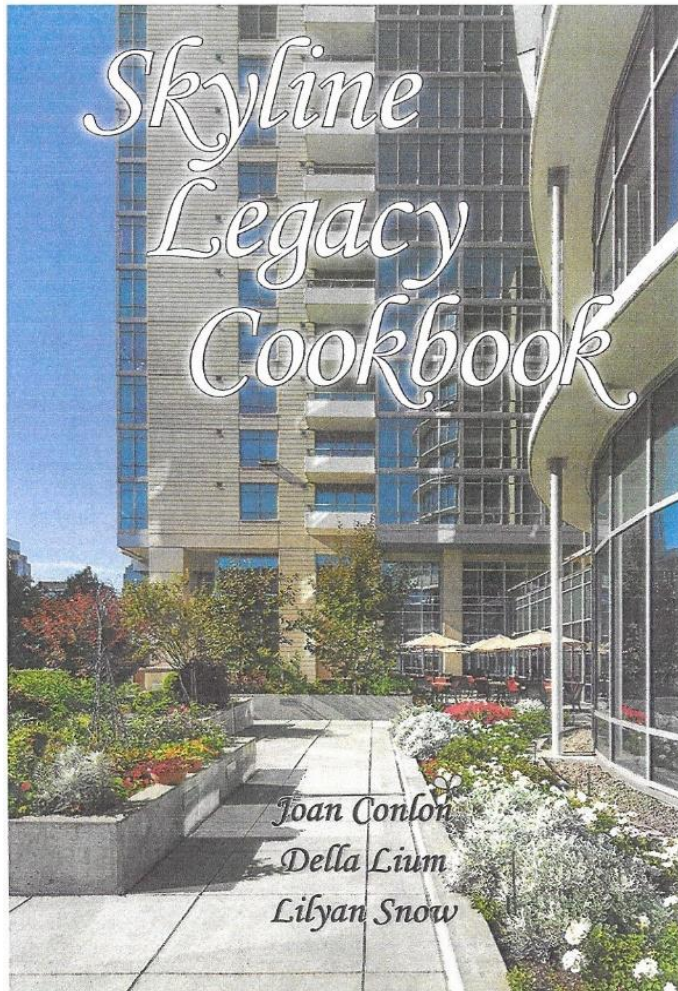
Skyline Legacy Cookbook
